Get Your PADI Open Water Scuba Diver Certification!

If you have always wanted to learn to scuba dive, discover new adventures, or simply see the world beneath the waves, this is where it starts. Deep Six offers the PADI Open Water Course in THREE formats to fit your schedule.

1. **Weekend Course:** Conducted over two weekends, you'll complete the classroom and pool sessions the first weekend and finish up with your open water certification dives the following weekend.
2. **Weeknight Course:** Meet your instructor for the classroom and pool sessions on four to five consecutive evenings and complete your open water certification dives on the weekend. Start on Monday, done on Sunday!
3. **Private Lessons:** For one-on-one attention or very small groups, you and your instructor can customize a schedule for you.

PADI E-LEARNING: ALL coursework is now done through online ELearning. Sign up at our website, www.deepsixintl.com to purchase and complete the classroom portion of the course. Work at your own pace, there will be a review of the material your first day of class.

COURSE FEES: includes class materials, certification card, use of scuba equipment, and your certification dives. Students should own their own mask, snorkel, fins (with boots if needed), wetsuit (if desired) and surface signal. These items are critical to each diver, and unique to each person. Most SCUBA equipment can be acquired through rentals, but it is necessary to have these basics fit correctly and comfortably to have a successful and safe dive. Consult your instructor on how to choose the proper fit and brand for your needs.

COURSE MENU

Enriched Air Nitrox \$175

The Enriched Air NITROX course is PADI's most popular specialty. Diving enriched air lets you safely extend your no-decompression bottom time, which means more time underwater and shorter surface intervals. After you complete your ELearning for this course, you'll attend one classroom session for review. Two open water dives are optional.

Advanced Open Water Diver \$280

The PADI Advanced Open Water Diver course is all about exploration, excitement, and experiences. It is designed to increase your confidence and build your scuba skills to become more comfortable in the water. You can enroll in this course as soon as you complete your PADI Open Water certification, so it's a great way to get more dives under your belt while continuing to learn under the supervision of your PADI Instructor. This course builds on what you've learned and develops new skills by introducing you to different ways to have fun while scuba diving. Includes five dives!

Rescue Diver \$250

The PADI Rescue Diver Course is often called one of the most challenging, yet rewarding, SCUBA courses by those who complete it. This course expands on what you already know about preventing problems and teaches you how to manage them if they occur.
